GREENACRES VISIONING PROJECT

On August 20, 2018, the City Council entered into an agreement with Redevelopment Management Associates, LLC (RMA), to lead the City in the development of a City Vision and Brand and create a Strategic Action Plan that would provide a framework to promote, develop, redevelop and encourage sustainable growth and a diversified tax base within the City of Greenacres.

This process began with a market analysis, followed by public and business and community stakeholder meetings which solicited ideas and feedback on the City's current identity and aspirational brand all leading toward the creation of a collaborative community vision. This important feedback has assisted with the development of a realistic, achievable strategic action plan for the City's short-term and long-term goals.

RMA will present the Strategic Action Plan and unveil City branding ideas on Monday February 25, 2019, at 6:00 p.m., at the Greenacres City Hall, 5800 Melaleuca Lane. This important meeting will lay the groundwork for future changes and improvements in the City that will provide for a community where we all want to live, learn, work and play. CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

The following is a randomized list of notable accomplishments by City Council over the most recent fiscal year and go beyond "normal" day-to-day services. These projects relate to the City Council's 2018 major goals and priorities from July through December, 2018.

- Authorized the County to distribute \$322,513 in J.A.G. grant funding for the Adult & Juvenile Re-Entry Services program.
- Approved the site plan to construct a Dairy Queen on the southwest corner of Empire Way & Lake Worth Road.
- Authorized expenditures from the Law Enforcement Forfeiture Funds to purchase 10 (ten) Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) cameras.
- Accepted a Little Free Library donated by Wes Kain of the DIY Vanilla Ice Project.
- Selected Redevelopment Management Associates (RMA) as the City's visioning consultant.
- Approved new flooring for the gym at the Community Center and LED lighting for City streets using surtax funds.
- Approved the inclusion of a solid waste collection assessment in 2018 PBC property tax bill.
- Authorized a Traffic Control Jurisdiction Agreement with PBSO and the Reserve at Summit.
- Adopted Fiscal Year 2019 Budget.
- Received a \$3,000 donation by the Kiwanis Club.
- Approved a 5-year lease agreement with the Florida Dept. of Health for the former City Hall building.

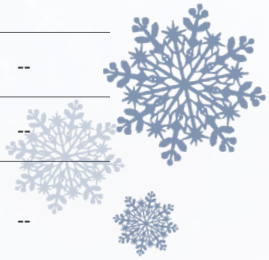

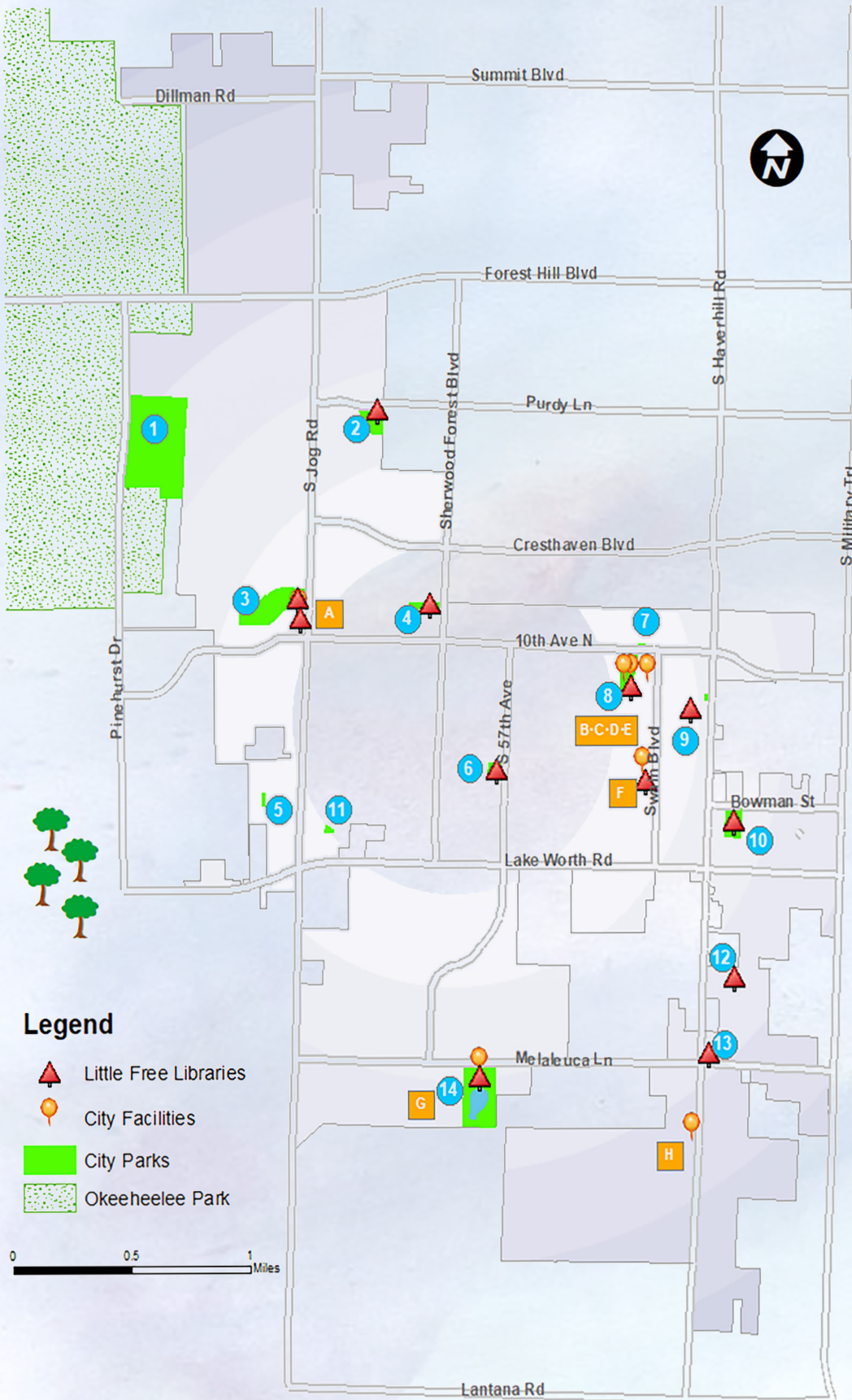
