The following is a randomized list of notable accomplishments by City Council over the most recent fiscal year and go beyond "normal" day-to-day services. These projects relate to the City Council's 2019 major goals and priorities from January through July, 2019.

- » Adopted resolution of support and partnership with the US Census Bureau and creation of a Complete Count Committee to ensure that all residents are counted. Various Federal and State funds received are calculated based on the number of residents, so counting all residents is important to ensure the City's ability to continue to provide services to the entire community.
- » Approved an Interlocal agreement with Palm Beach County for Emergency Medical Services Grant Equipment to assist our Fire Rescue Department.
- » Authorized application and execution of Agreement for CDBG Phase VI Funding for the Original Section Drainage Improvements Project to increase water capacity through improvements to the outfall connections on either side of the L-11 Canal.
- » Approved an agreement with Florida Power and Light for conversion of streetlights to Light Emitting Diode (LED) to provide for better visibility and improved safety.
- » Approved two (2) Inter-Local Residential and Commercial Annexations.
- » Authorized creation of a Charter Review Committee and ratification of nine members to meet as needed to review the City's Charter and make recommendations to the City Council for consideration and placement on future election ballots.
- » Approved Solid Waste Franchise Agreement for the collection of Solid Waste, Recycling, Bulk and Yard Waste for a five (5) year period.
- » Approved amendments/updates to Building Codes regarding Noise, Nuisance and Property Maintenance.
- » Authorized ban of Medical Marijuana Treatment Center dispensing facilities within the City of Greenacres.

Approved City Budget - Fiscal Year 2020

The City Council scheduled public hearings on September 5^h and 19th at 6:00 p.m. to adopt a budget for Fiscal Year 2020 *(October 1, 2019 – September 30, 2020)*. The City's general operating budget for FY2020 is \$30.9 million, which is \$2.04 million more than the Fiscal Year 2019 budget.

The increase is mostly due to an increase in interfund transfers into the Capital Project Funds. The FY2020 budget includes funding to enhance Fire Rescue services, and Community and Recreation Services activities and events.

Each August, the Palm Beach County Property Appraiser's Office sends a Notice of Proposed Property Taxes to all property owners showing the taxable value of the property and the property tax information for all taxing authorities. Of the total property tax bill, the City's property tax portion represents approximately 27% with the remaining 73% going to the County, School District, and other independent taxing authorities.

City of Greenacres - Solid Waste Services

New City-provided trash containers will be available for use this December for our curbside pick-up residents. The new containers will display our City seal and will be available in three (3) different sizes, see below. Advanced Disposal Services, our current solid waste provider, will distribute the containers based on your selection.

In September, residents who currently receive curbside pickup service, will receive an informational flyer and a postcard survey to select a desired container size. Please fill out the card information and return by mail. The City asks for your selection no later than October 5, 2019, to provide you with the service that will best suit your needs. Container size samples are available for viewing at City Hall.


If residents are unable to respond to the survey, a 96-gallon container will be provided. The containers are free of charge, and will be delivered to each property by mid-November. You may exchange or change your container size at no additional charge through February 1, 2020.

What to Remember:

- » Do not use your new container until December 1, 2019.
- » Garbage collection will be provided two (2) days a week
- » Customers will receive a 96-gallon container unless a different selection is made.
- » Detailed container and collection guidelines will be attached on your new container.
- » All garbage must be placed inside the container for collection.
- » Collection days for all solid waste <u>will not</u> change.

	SANITATION SERVICES
RECYCLING	The recycling program will remain the same. If you need recycling bins, please contact the Public Works Department at 561-642-2071. Your request will be submitted to Advanced Disposal Services, who will deliver the bins within 10 business days.
VEGETATION	Tree branches and palm fronds should be neatly stacked in a pile. Tree trimmings placed at the curb must be cut into pieces that are no more than six (6) feet in length and weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds each to facilitate manual loading. Items that exceed this size shall be tagged and photographed and the information will be forwarded to the Public Works Department. Your waste assessment and collection service is intended for routine landscape maintenance, not debris generated by land clearing and tree removal activities. Do not mix garbage with yard waste (vegetation). Home Owners Association's that have a contract with a landscaper to provide landscape maintenance to common grounds shall be responsible for ensuring the prompt collection and disposal of yard waste.
DEBRIS	Debris (other than palm fronds and tree branches) such as leaves, tree and hedge trimmings, pine needles, etc. should be containerized, preferably in a garbage can, paper lawn and refuse bags, or plastic bags. Piles that contain mixed materials, or that are excessively large, cannot be efficiently collected manually or mechanically and impede the ability of the waste hauler to provide quality, affordable service to the hundreds of other residential customers on the route. Residents can contract with an outside source to remove the material, and if you have hired a commercial landscaper, make sure they include removal in their quote.
BULK	Bulk collection service will continue to be provided one (1) day per week and include appliances, furniture and any other large household items that do not fit in your container.

Solid waste must be placed in front of your home, within six (6) feet of the edge of the traveled portion of the roadway. Do not place or stack waste over water or gas meters, under low hanging branches or utility wires, or within 4 feet of mailboxes, fire hydrants or signs. Solid waste collection services are conducted from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday (except Thanksgiving and Christmas Day). Please make sure to place your waste outside prior to 7:00 a.m., for prompt collection.




After School Programs
