

Greenacres effected closures & openings due to COVID-19 precautions as of July 16, 2020

Greenacres Park Closures and some openings: (Parks Hours are 7AM-8PM until further notice)

Bowman Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Burrowing Owl Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Empire Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Gladiator Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Heather Estates Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Community Park – Jogging Path, Tennis, pickleball, and racquetball – OPEN Approved renters *ONLY* allowed on fields.

Freedom Park – Volleyball court, Jogging path – OPEN (Park Gate will be locked promptly at 8PM)
Approved renters ONLY allowed on fields.

Ira Van Bullock Park – Park and benches are open for passive use; approved renters ONLY allowed on fields.

Oasis Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Ramblewood Park – Park and benches are open for passive use.

Veterans Memorial Park – Park remains fully CLOSED

All city playgrounds, pavilions, basketball courts & public restrooms remain CLOSED until further notice.

Please maintain 6' physical distancing at all times in City Parks
