How the 2020 Census Affects You

"The goal of the **2020 Census** is to count everyone once, only once, and in the right place"

What is the Census?

The U.S. Census was first taken in 1790, as mandated by the Constitution. It is taken every 10 years and defines who we are as a nation. The census affects political representation, directs billions of dollars in government funding, and guides local decision-makers in important community planning efforts, including where to build new roads, hospitals and schools.



Why does your participation in the 2020 Census Matter?

2020 Census responses drive decisions on the allocation of more than \$675 Billion in Federal funds to States and Communities over a 10-year period.

Is the information provided confidential?

Yes. Every Census Bureau worker takes an oath for life to protect the confidentiality of census responses. When you respond to the census, your answers are kept anonymous. They are used only to produce statistics.

The U.S. Census Bureau is bound by law to protect your answers and keep them strictly confidential. The law ensures that your private information is never published and that your answers cannot be used against you by any government agency or court.

2020 Census Questionnaire

This is the **first** U.S. census to offer options to respond online or by phone, in addition to the option to respond on a paper form as with previous censuses. The 2020 Census questionnaire is simple and safe. Only a few simple questions are asked of each person.

When will you receive the 2020 Census Questionnaire?

Census questionnaires will be mailed or delivered to every U.S. household by April of 2020. Census takers will visit households that did not return a questionnaire by mail in April through July of 2020.

You can help your City receive the funds and social benefits to which it is entitled by completing and mailing in an accurate 2020 Census Questionnaire.

CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

The following is a randomized list of notable accomplishments by City Council over the most recent fiscal year and go beyond “normal” day-to-day services. These projects relate to the City Council's 2019 major goals and priorities from July through December, 2019.

- Established a taxable valuation and levied an ad valorem tax on property located within the Corporate Limits of Greenacres, Florida for the year ending December 31, 2019, and adopted an operating budget for the Fiscal Year 2020 beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020.
- Approved the solid waste franchise agreement with Advanced Disposal Services Solid Waste Southeast, Inc., to include collecting and hauling residential and commercial solid waste, effective for the period of October 1, 2019, to September 30, 2024.
- Authorized the adoption of a Statewide Mutual Aid Agreement between the State of Florida and the City of Greenacres, authorizing the State to provide emergency aid and assistance to the City in the event of a disaster or emergency, in accordance with the Emergency Management Act.
- Adopted an Ordinance relating to *Health, Sanitation and Nuisances* whereby municipalities can abate nuisances related to drugs, prostitution, stolen property, gang activity and pain management clinics.
- Approved contract between the Florida Department of Corrections and the City of Greenacres for the purpose of providing work squads to the City during Fiscal Year 2020.

The City of Greenacres serves as a Passport Acceptance location. Once the intake process has been completed at our office, your passport application is then forwarded to a Passport Agency for processing as the U.S. Department of State issues the passports.

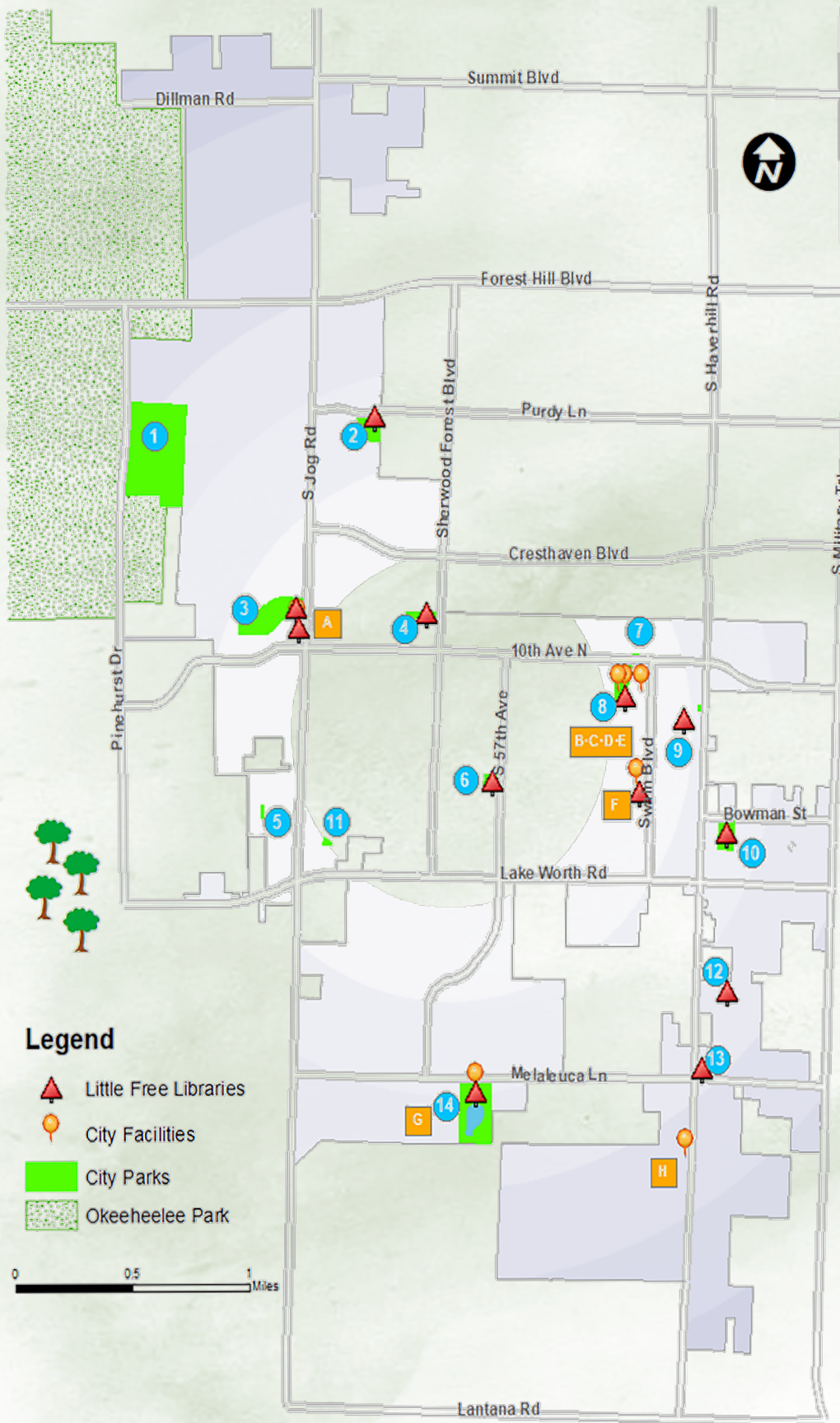
AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

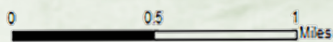
