During the real estate boom of the 1920's Lawrence Carter Swain accumulated several hundred acres of land to create a community for the working class, setting aside some acres for a county school and town use, and sold lots for \$225. By the time the Town of Greenacres City was incorporated in 1926, the population was 1,250.

Our City has grown a great deal since then and in 1980 it was renamed the City of Greenacres. Our population has increased to approximately 40,000 and we are the eighth largest of the 39 municipalities in Palm Beach County.

While it is important to remember our history and what we have accomplished, it is also important to look to the future and continue to make Greenacres a great place to Live, Learn, Work and Play.

Fiscal Year 2021- Accomplishments

Fiscal Year 2021 Annual Budget

The City Council scheduled public hearings on September 8th and 22nd at 6:00 p.m. to adopt a budget for Fiscal Year 2022 (*October 1, 2021 - September, 2022*). The City's proposed operating budget for FY2022 is 49.4 million.

Chickasaw Road

An Interlocal Agreement was adopted between the City of Greenacres and the Lake Worth Drainage District for the transfer of ownership to allow for roadway improvements to Chickasaw Road to ensure the safe and efficient flow of traffic.

Solid Waste

In March 2021, an Interlocal Agreement was approved for the delivery of municipal solid waste to designated facilities and for a municipal revenue sharing recycling program between the City of Greenacres and the Solid Waste Authority of Palm Beach County.

Freedom Park

Approval for the construction of four (4) sand volleyball courts at Freedom Park.

Adult Soccer League

Agreement approval for the City of Greenacres and Beaches Adult Soccer League (BASL); to allow the operation of the City's recreational and competitive adult soccer league and the use of the City's soccer fields.

Scholarship Awards

Presented six (6) Educational Scholarship Awards to resident students as recommended by the City's Scholarship Committee.

Fire Rescue

Authorized an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County for reimbursement of emergency medical services equipment.

Annexation

Annexation approval for three (3) parcels of land totaling approximately 10.58 acres, located on the west side of Ranchette Road. Annexation approval through referendum for 35 acres on the north side of Nash Trail.

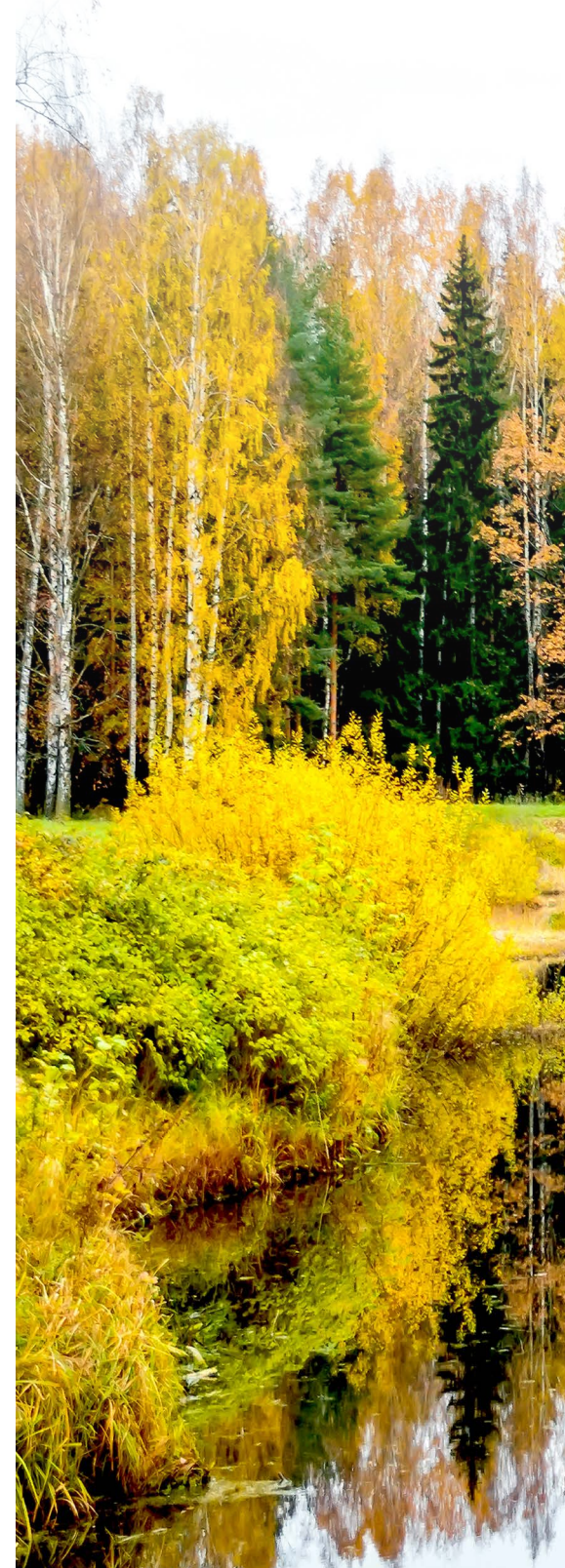

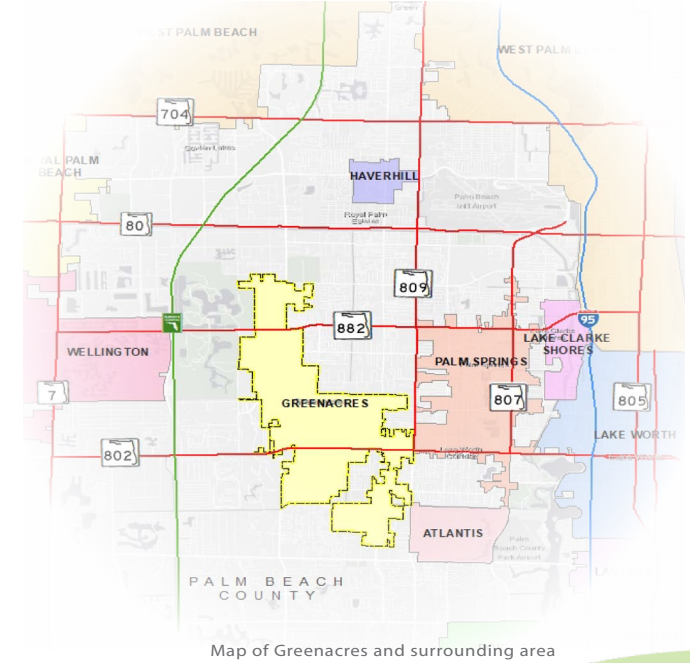

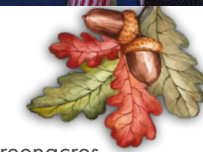
