MAYOR & CITY COUNCIL ACTIONS

The following is a randomized list of notable accomplishments by City Council over the most recent fiscal year and go beyond "normal" day-to-day services. These projects relate to the City Council's 2020 major goals and priorities from July through December, 2020

- Established a taxable valuation and levying an ad valorem tax on property located within the Corporate Limits of Greenacres, Florida for the year ending December 31, 2020, and adopted an operating budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2021.
- Approved a professional services agreement for governmental consulting and lobbying services to assist the City in obtaining state-level funding for various City projects, effective October 19, 2020
- City of Greenacres was authorized to participate on the Public Emergency Medical Transportation Supplemental Payment Program for Medicaid managed care patients, effective for the period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.
- Authorized to initiate the negotiation process for an inter-local service boundary agreement between the City of Greenacres and Palm Beach County, pursuant to Chapter 171, part II, Florida Statutes.
- Approved agreement between the City of Greenacres and William Medley Construction, Inc for the construction of a court and the installation of 24-Station Bankshot Recreational System at Freedom Park.

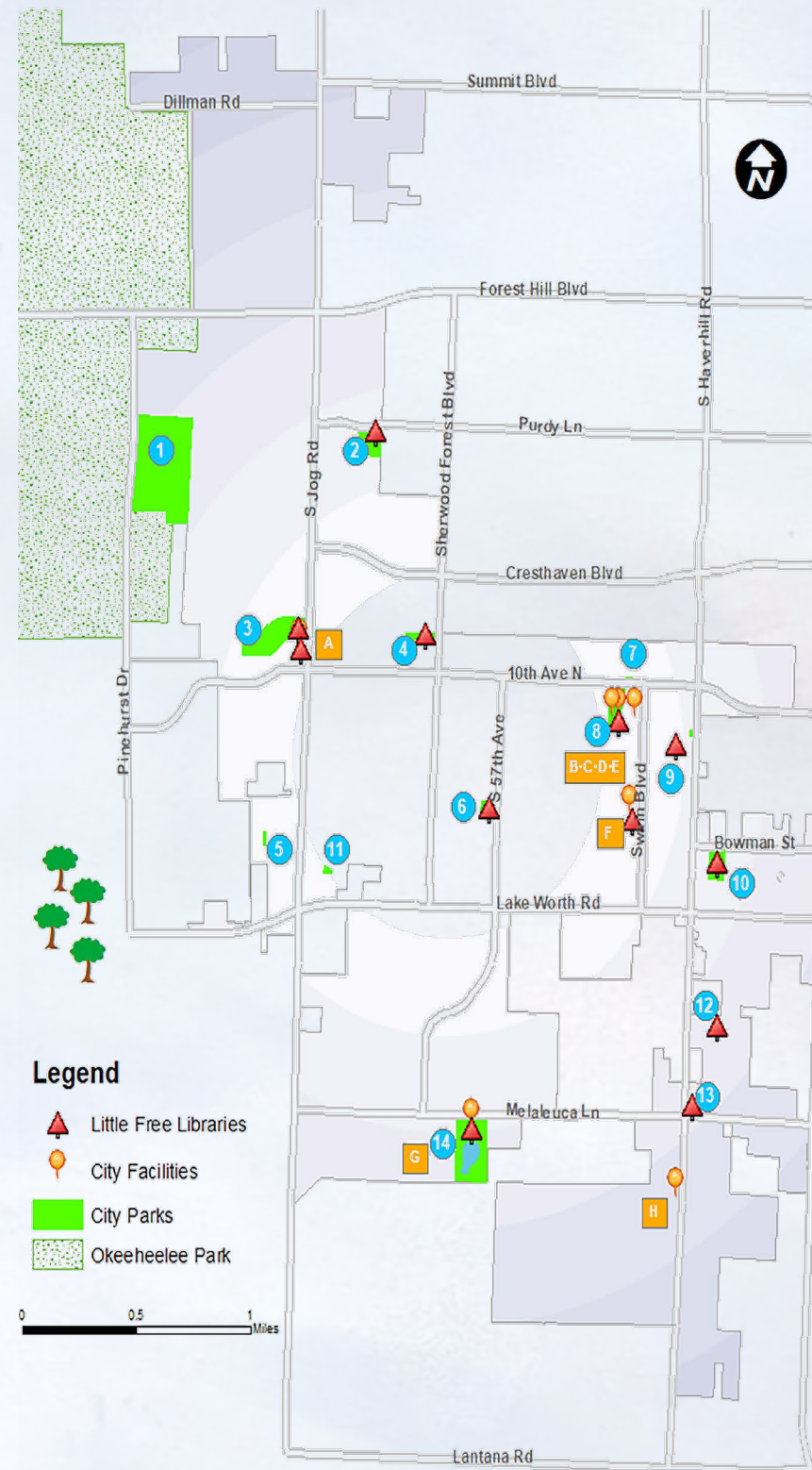

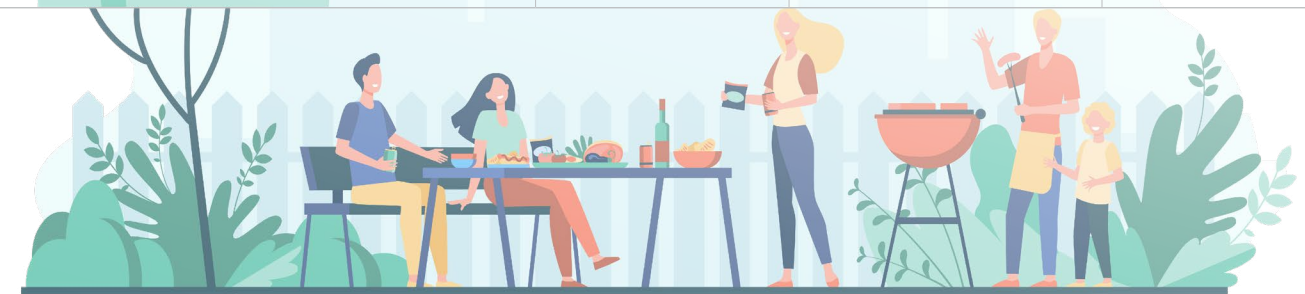
