<p>Senior Health and Resource Fair Sponsor:</p> <p>This fair is designed to provide information for senior citizens to learn more about services that are available to them. Over 20 vendors will be on site to discuss programs and services that benefit seniors as well as offering free senior health screenings, health-related presentations and much more!</p>
<p>Senior/Adult Programs:</p> <p>Two different groups of seniors meet in the Community Center. One group attends the board games day (Mon-Fri. from 10 am - 12 pm). With 15-20 seniors in attendance, a sponsor could provide coffee and donuts and get to know them. The second group attends ballroom dancing with 40-50 seniors in attendance (Tuesdays from 1 - 3 pm). A sponsor could set up a table in the ballroom dance area and mingle with the seniors.</p>
<p>Activity Ticket Sponsor:</p> <p>The sponsorship donation is turned into activity tickets for children to use at the City's large community events. Tickets can be handed out by the sponsor, a PBSO Deputy or a Greenacres Fire Fighter. This program is designed for the children whose parents can't afford the cost of the activity tickets (face painter, bounce house, etc), and is a GREAT way to build positive relationships between a family and a PBSO Deputy or Fire Fighter!</p>
<p>Little Free Library & Free Little Art Gallery Program:</p> <p>The City operates Little Free Libraries, home of the "Take a book- Leave a book." The libraries provide free children/teen/adult books in 3 languages and enhances literacy in neighborhoods that may not have access to a public library.
