

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# WHY IS THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN IMPORTANT





The comprehensive plan is important because:

It reflects the City's vision

It provides continuity

It provides guidance for shaping the appearance of the community including advising developers what the City is looking for

It helps to prepare the City's annual Capital Improvement Plan

It provides justification for decisions including assisting in obtaining grant monies

It is statutorily required

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### NEED TO UPDATE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN





Each local government shall determine at least every seven (7) years whether plan amendments are necessary to reflect changes in state requirements since the last update of the comprehensive plan and notify DEO by letter on its determination. DEO publishes a schedule indicating to local government when such determination should be made. If the local government determines that such amendments are necessary, then the plan amendments will be prepared transmitted to DEO within one year of the determination. If the local government fails to either timely notify DEO of its determination to update the comprehensive plan or to transmit such update amendments, it may not amend its comprehensive plan until it complies with these requirements. Amendments submitted to DEO to update comprehensive plans will be reviewed through the state coordinated process.
